Handling instructions

Please be aware that all dogs in pain or stressful situations can bite.

Describe the dog's general temperament –timid, excitable or cautious? How best to treat them to get them out of the car? Will the dog tolerate being physically moved (picked up) or would they prefer to be led on their leash? Do you use stairs or a ramp to get the dog in and out of the car normally? Where is it stored?
